Awards are presented to 14 youth in seven categories to reflect many different areas of interest and to promote a more positive image of youth within the community. Award categories include:



## **The Opportunity**

#### **Key Dates**

#### Feb 15 - March 15, 2023 - Nominations

Call for nominations for the RBC Spirit of the Capital Youth Awards open on Youth Ottawa's website. We invite anyone in the community to nominate a youth between the ages of 14-21. Youth Ottawa staff evaluate and score applications, screening four applicants per category to be interviewed.

 How do sponsors participate? We invite sponsors to promote the nominations. Youth Ottawa will provide any communications materials.

#### April 11 - 17, 2023 - Finalist Interviews

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to interview.

 How do sponsors participate? Award sponsors are invited to conduct interviews alongside a Youth Ottawa staff. Interviews will be conducted throughout the week via zoom. Sponsors will select the two finalists in their category.

#### May 23, 2023 - Meet and Greet

The meet and greet is an opportunity for recipients to meet one another and the sponsors ahead of the gala. There is food, networking opportunities and icebreakers.

• **How do sponsors particate?** Sponsors are invited to send 1-4 staff members to attend the meet and greet. This is a more intimate setting ahead of the gala.

#### June 29, 2023 - The Gala!

Over 300 people gather for the award gala to celebrate the recipients. Guests include family, friends, teachers, community partners, city councillors and the Mayor.

• **How do sponsors participate?** Sponsors are invited to attend the awards and are given speaking opportunities depending on the sponsorship package chosen. There is a cocktail hour, followed by the award reception.





# Sponsorship Opportunities

#### Award Sponsor – \$8,000 (x 7)
